## 1. NMTIA Business

## 2. Updates

#### a. 350 Ocean (old trophy shop)

A warrant was served & 3 were arrested for gambling ring based out of this property. On 4/26/2018 at 6:30pm at Excelsior Library, there will be a pre-application meeting to build 24 units at this location.

## b. Cow Palace (gun show protest)

Prudence was there. June 2 & 3, Cow Palace is having another meeting. Prudence & others welcome to protest.

#### c. Prop 68 (clean water & safe parks act)

This may apply to some Bay Area issues. Expansion of parks for park-poor neighborhoods, SF waterfronts, etc.

#### d. ParkRecOpenspaceZoningAcquisitionCommittee (PROZAC)

Steve: Will purchase open space for the SF parks. Two people per district are appointed to address concerns. Advocates for park & rec issues and open space issues. Only deals with government-owned property.

## 3. **Senate Bill 827**

Proposed by Senator Weiner

Presented by Todd David, Executive Director of the SF Housing Action Coalition and President of the Friends of Noe Valley.

- a. It does 3 things:
  - i. If near transit corridor, minimum height of 45 feet (will upzone by 1 story)
  - ii. No single-housing zoning requirements (must be multi-family units, and a portion will be affordable housing)
  - iii. Removed parking minimum requirements
- b. If you make \$75k or less, you qualify for subsidized/affordable housing
- c. Would implement in 2021
- d. "Transit Corridor" is considered around a train line, ½ mile w/in any direction.
- e. Impact fees charged to developments, goes towards transit.

  Neighbor... was told that 70% of impact fees are actually forgiven.
- f. Endorsed by affordable housing groups.
- g. Not present to talk about opposing side: Elizabeth Fromer, President of the Liberty Hill Neighborhood Association and representative of the Coalition of San Francisco Neighborhoods (CSFN)
- h. Concerns expressed by neighbors about ownership vs. rentals, affordability, transit issues, single family house displacement, sewage issues due to high density, etc.

#### b. 2<sup>nd</sup> Annual Mission Terrace Garden Tour

May 6th. Sixteen homes opening their garden up for tours.
