

SF's Traffic Calming Program - Speed Bumps

Some things to know about SF's traffic calming program:

1. Approval considerations include:
 - a. Proximity to parks, schools, etc.
 - b. A majority of households on the block must also approve traffic calming solutions.
 - c. The 85th percentile speed (prevailing speed) is considered. Traffic calming measured are considered when speeders go over 5mph beyond limit
 - d. Collected speed data is considered good for 5 years.
2. There are about 80-100 applications each year, and only 40 are approved.
3. Deadline for applications is June 30th each year. The approval process can take multiple years (12-24 months or so).
